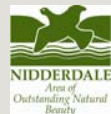

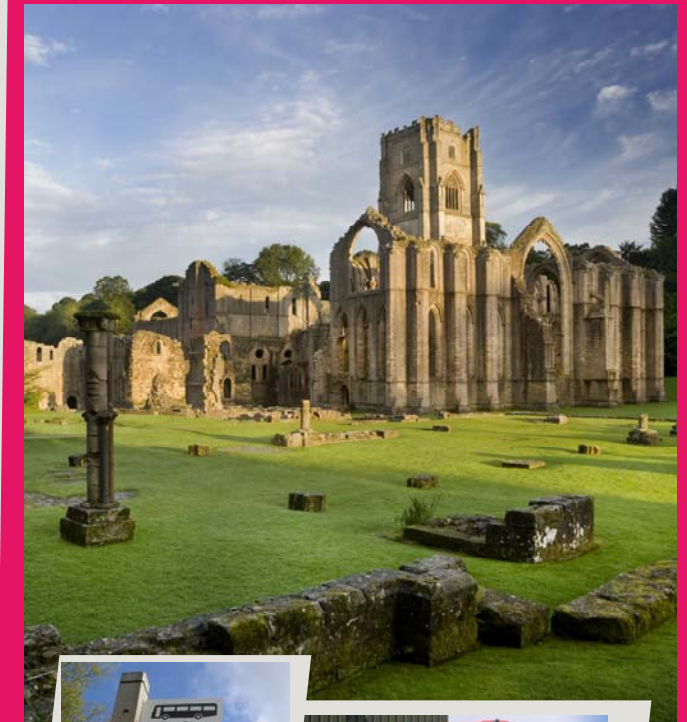

Ripon Roweller service 139 connects Ripon Bus Station to Fountains Abbey and Studley Royal, a World Heritage Site owned by the National Trust. The Roweller also connects with the popular **36 service** running between Leeds, Harrogate and Ripon making this remarkable estate easier to reach.

Why should I use this service?

This competitively priced service aims to encourage people to travel to Fountains Abbey by bus rather than car. This will help reduce traffic congestion and make local roads safer for cyclists and pedestrians. A reduction in car miles will also benefit the environment by reducing carbon emissions and, in a small way, help minimise climate change.

When does the service run?

The National Trust sponsored Ripon Roweller service runs every Sunday and Bank Holiday Monday from 4 April to 31 October 2010. The service operates on an hourly basis as per the timetable above. The Roweller also operates weekdays and Saturdays (call Traveline: 0871 200 22 33 for details).

How much does it cost?

The cost of an adult single journey from Ripon to Fountains Abbey is £1.95. The return fare is £3.05. Senior citizen concessionary travel passes, *Day Gold* and *Gold Card* tickets are also valid for use on this service. Visitors showing a valid and appropriately dated Roweller or Harrogate and District 36 bus ticket at Fountains Abbey admission points are offered half price entry to this World Heritage Site.

Where does the bus stop?

On the outward journey from Ripon, the Roweller will drop passengers off in the village of Studley Roger and at two locations within Fountains Abbey and Studley Royal estate: by Studley Lakeside and by the Visitor Centre (see map overleaf). Visitors wishing to return to Ripon can board the bus at the Visitor Centre bus stop.
